The month of September saw many historical military events.

Sept. 1

1939, 5:30AM German armies invade Poland to start World War 2.

Sept. 2

31 BCE, The Roman Legions under Caesar defeat Mark Anthony's naval force at the Battle of Actium.

1864, General William Sherman captures Atlanta.

1945, V-J Day declared.

Sept. 7

1940, German Luftwaffe begins the Blitz bombing campaign against London.

Sept. 13

1814, Francis Scott Key watches the bombardment of Fort Henry in Baltimore Harbor, inspiring the verses of the Star Spangled Banner.

Sept. 14

1812, Napoleon enters Moscow.

Sept. 15

1916, First use of tanks in combat at the Battle of the Somme.

Sept. 17

1862, The bloodiest day in US Military history as 26,000 Americans are casualties at the battle of Antietam.

Sept. 18

1947, The United States Air Force is established as a separate military service.

Sept. 26

1918, The last major battle of WWI begins as the Allies attack along a 40 mile front in the Battle of the Argonne.

Sept. 28

1066, Duke William of Normandy lands at Pevensey, Sussex and begins his conquest of England.

Colorado Military Historians (CMH) is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to promote historical wargaming and the study of military history. Founded in 1965, CMH meets monthly on the second Sunday of the month, except in May when the meeting is deferred to the third Sunday. The meeting starts at noon at the Baker Recreation Center, 6751 Irving Street (just a few blocks west of Federal Blvd), Denver, Colorado. The club also hosts gaming at least one Friday night a month, called "Friday Night Fights" (FNF) at 7:00 p.m. One Friday of the month will be held at the Baker Community Center. The other Friday meetings will be held at a future determined location. See website for latest information.

CMH maintains ties with numerous local, regional and national groups to help promote the hobby. CMH is governed by member-elected officers who serve on the Board of Directors (executive board). Terms of office are one year, with elections held at the May meeting. New members are accepted after attending three CMH functions and a vote of the membership. Dues are \$35.00 per year, payable in January. Members wishing to receive a snail-mailed newsletter subscription must pay an additional fee of \$15.00 per year. Authors retain ownership of articles and graphics published. CMH reserves the right to edit or reject submissions to the newsletter.
